Many thanks for your interest in the Queer Death Studies Network (QDS) and this second international workshop, co-organised by QDS, GEXcel International Collegium for Advanced Transdisciplinary Gender Studies and Karlstad University.

First, content-related practicalities:

This particular workshop aims to explore the understanding (or rather, different understandings) of the concept of 'queer' in the context of Death Studies. What does 'queer' do to both the concept of death

and Death Studies as such? What kind of platform of engagement with death does 'queer' create? This is also why we ask all the participants to continuously keep in mind two questions:

- What, according to you, is now Queer Death Studies?
- How do you see your own activity (academic, artistic, activist, other) in relation to QDS?

These are the two questions that will form the starting point for our reflection and discussion in the closing panel and shall be the guidelines kept at the back of our minds throughout the workshop. Furthermore, each panel is planned in a way that there is 30-40min for a presentation of each paper and ca 20-30 min for Q&A. This Q&A space is designed and offered as an invitation for every participant not only to engage with the content of each paper, but also to bring these reflections into a broader problematisation of QDS.
