About Anthony Lewis Brooks

Acknowledged as a third culture thinker originating groundbreaking research, ongoingly refined over three decades, Brooks is regarded a world pioneer in digital media and its use with the disabled community.

His work is responsible for national and international projects, industry start-up, commercial products, and a family of patents on apparatus and method.

Over a dozen international keynote talks and near 200 publications has led to his research being widely adopted, which has resulted in noteworthy appointments e.g. as Danish IFIP (UNESCO) representative, and EU commission project panel examiner, reviewer and rapporteur; additionally Brooks has been PhD examiner in many countries and is on numerous international boards.
