TAN research seminar on new interdisciplinary perspectives on Techno-Anthropological Research

CALL FOR PRESENTATIONS

Monday, January 8 2018. Copenhagen and Aalborg (video conference)

Techno-Anthropology is now a well-established study program and a rapidly growing research enterprise consisting of research groups at different departments and faculties. The aim of the seminar is to present current techno-anthropological research and facilitate both collaboration between different techno-anthropological research groups as well involvement of Master's students in Techno-Anthropological research projects.

Hence, we invite members of the techno-anthropological research groups to present their latest interdisciplinary Techno-Anthropological Research to their peers in the other groups. We particularly welcome presentations of ongoing research as well as planned future research (10 minutes presentation followed by 10 minutes Q&A). The seminar will serve as a showcase for newer Techno-Anthropological research and an incubator of research activities across research groups.

Those who would like to present their latest techno-anthropological research and ideas should send an e-mail to Petko Karadechev: petko@plan.aau.dk. Deadline for submission of abstracts is 15 December 2017. Authors of accepted abstracts will be directly contacted.

The program is set in Aalborg and Copenhagen (via video conference). The date is 8 January from 10:00 to 15:00. We expect no more than 12 presentations, and at least one presentation from each research environment involved in the Techno-Anthropology study program. Lunch and coffee is included.

In the name of knowledge sharing, and to facilitate the video format of the research seminar we recommend that all speakers upload their slides to an electronic repository for presentations prior to the seminar.
