About the Editors

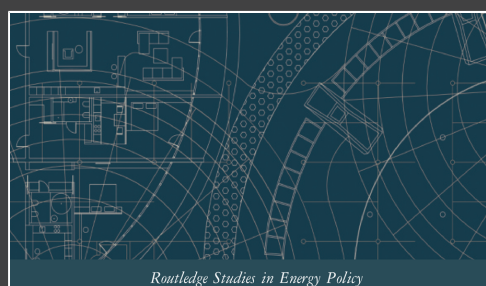
Finn Arler works as Professor of Ethics and Planning at the Department of Planning, Aalborg University, Denmark.

Karl Sperling, Ph.D., works as an associate professor in Energy Planning at the Department of Planning at Aalborg University.

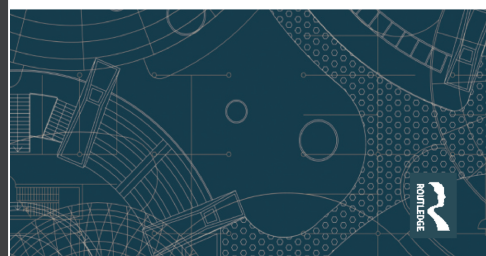
