When we talk about Open Access (OA), it is mostly in connection with scholarly articles in journals and the National Danish Strategy for Open Access is also especially focused on OA for journal articles. Right now, several initiatives are pushing, not only to publish scholarly monographies OA but also to make it easier for researchers to ensure that the publishers are transparent and thorough in their peer review processes when publishing OA.

In this session we will present initiatives as [DOAB](#) (Directory of Open Access Books) and [PRISM](#) (Peer Review Information Service for Monographs) – both services that helps researchers to navigate the jungle of OA-publishers for monographies. Niels Stern will also provide some guidelines for what to keep in mind when finding and choosing a publisher for a manuscript.
