My teaching experiences expand across all semesters for the five-year Danish Psychologist education (Cand.Psych.) and across many modules e.g. cognition, developmental psychology, psychological assessment, applied psychology, quantitative, qualitative and mixed methods. I currently teach/supervise in psychological assessment and testing, and on several modules related to a range of theoretical, empirical and applied aspects of developmental psychology, applied psychology, neuropsychological assessment and intervention with children, adolescents, and their families at the Master level. I also teach and supervise projects at the Master Programme Children's Clinic for Developmental Communication Disorders and supervise Master thesis. I also have teaching experiences at the Open University (EVU) and at the Medicine Department. I have experiences teaching and supervising in Danish, English and Spanish.

I've taught PhD courses in Denmark, Canada and Spain, and hosted Ph.D students from several countries during short stays in Aalborg University related to EU collaborations. I currently teach a PhD titled "hands-on analysis of qualitative interviews".

I participated in the original development of the psychology BA- and MA programme (Cand. Psych.) at Aalborg University and have participated in revising it several times. This involved developing and revising many of the current modules in Psychology. I also co-developed two Master programmes at the psychology department: KUR Klinik for Udviklings- og Rehabiliteringspsykologi (tidligere Klinik for Anvendt Neuro-Udvikling-og Kognition Psykologi (KANUK) and Clinic for Developmental Language and Communication Disorders (DCD)/Børnesprogklinikken (BspK). Recently I co-developed and taught a new 5-ECTS PhD course titled "hands-on analysis of qualitative interviews". During COVID I developed competences in how to teach established modules, and how to examine online.
